Republic Day marks an important event in India's history. It commemorates the enactment of the Constitution of India which came into effect on January 26, 1950, and made the nation into a republic. It is a well-known fact that India achieved independence from the British on August 15, 1947 after the long-drawn Indian independence movement. However, even after independence, our country had to rely on the modified colonial Government of India Act 1935 as we didn't have a permanent constitution, yet. On 29 August 1947, a resolution was created for the appointment of the Drafting Committee for drafting the official Constitution with Dr B R Ambedkar as chairman. The Constitution of India was adopted on November 26, 1949 but came into effect on January 26. Every year Republic Day is celebrated in India on 26th January with zeal and enthusiasm.

The main attraction of the day is the R-day parade which begins at Rajpath, Delhi and ends at India Gate. It consists of beautiful as well as informative tableaux by different States exhibiting their culture and heritage. The parade also honours the brave Indian Army, Navy, Air Force, police and paramilitary forces for protecting our nation. The military forces often display the latest weaponry, aircrafts and gadgets during the parade. The celebration usually ends with impressive flypasts by the Indian Forces. Spectacular parades at Janpath, New Delhi, consisting the Indian National Army and national flag hoisting in various parts of the country are common practices followed on this day.

After attaining independence from the British rule, the new constitution was enrolled by the drafting committee under the deanship of Dr BR Ambedkar. The Indian Constitution came into effect on 26 January 1950, which declared India's occurrence as an independent republic. January 26th was chosen as the date because on this day in 1930, the Indian National Congress revealed Purna Swaraj, the declaration of India's independence from the colonial rule. Republic Day signifies the right spirit of Independent and individual India. The important symbols of the festival include the exhibition of military equipment, the national flag and military equipment. Awards are presented to the brave soldiers in the form of Paramvir Chakra, Ashok Chakra, and Vir Chakra. Even children and general citizens who have displayed courage in times of adversity are honoured with awards.

National flag hoisting in schools and colleges are regular. Cultural events advocating India's struggle for freedom is held countrywide. As a part of it, Tirumala Engineering College observes Republic day celebrations in the college campus. Management of Tirumala Engineering College actively participates in National events like this.
